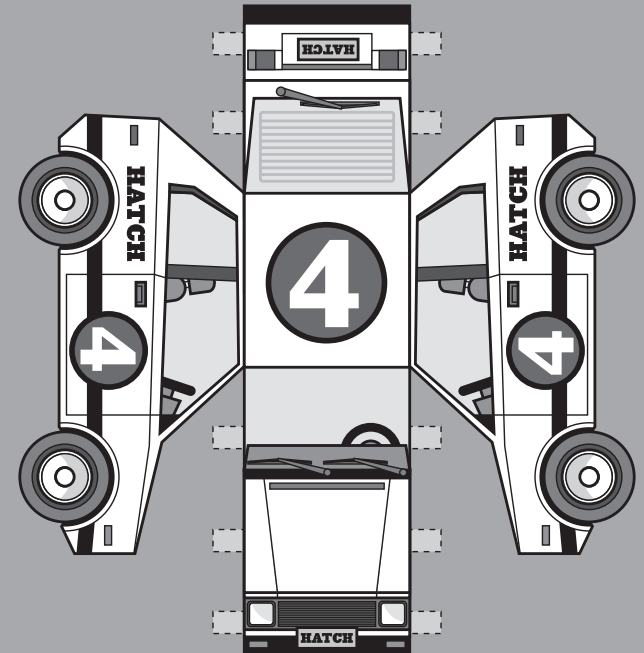

name** in the digital file name.

in the memo line. Mail to the address above.

**HATCH members:** \$10.00 for TWO (2)  
entries, \$5.00 each additional entry (no limit).

**Non-HATCH members:** \$20.00 for TWO (2)  
entries, \$5.00 each additional entry (no limit).

You can become a HATCH member at the time  
of entry for \$30.00. (\$40 for two entries and  
membership, \$5.00 each additional entry). To

Entry fees are non-refundable. All artwork must  
be for sale. HATCH will take a 30% commission  
from artwork sold during the exhibition.

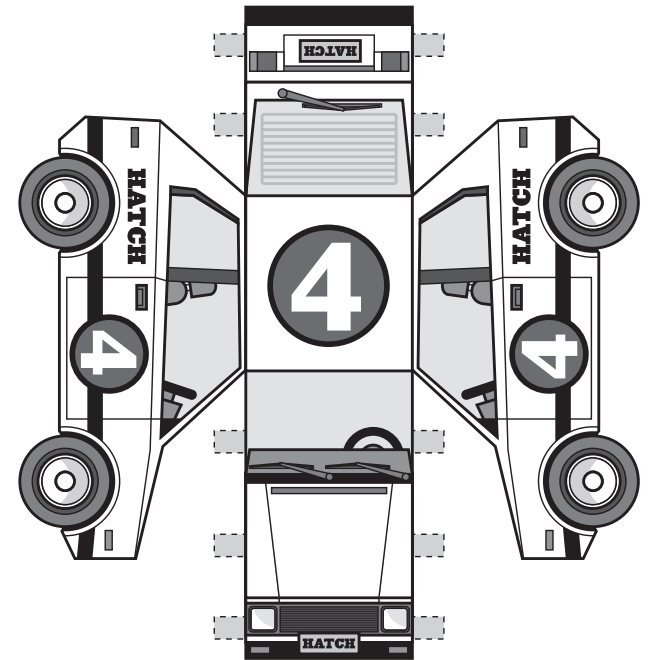
